Intern Host Families Needed for 2017-2018

The **March 31 deadline** to find new host families is quickly approaching! Please consider opening your home to an LNFI intern for one semester in 2017-18. It's a wonderful opportunity to have a cultural exchange experience without leaving your home. The number of interns the PTO can bring to LNFI depends on how many host families apply by the deadline and on funds raised this year.

We are aiming for 10 interns again next year! 10 interns require 24 host families (10 families per semester plus four back-up host families). So far, **six families have signed up**, so we have a long way to go! New families and those who have hosted before are welcome to host. Sign up to host in the fall or spring or to be a back-up host family.

- Host families provide a private bedroom (not bathroom), food, and transportation to/from school (school bus OK).
- Two host families are needed per intern – families only commit to host for one semester.
