WHY A FAMILY STAY?

One can always be a tourist, but a family stay is a unique opportunity to be immersed in the language, culture, and daily life of their family.

One student per family allows a true immersion experience, and each student has a host family experience to call their own.

PROGRAM TEAM: TEACHERS/ LEADERS


- Work with L&F coordinator to plan all aspects of the program
- Hold preparation meetings with students to help prepare for a successful experience
- Teachers/leaders are students' first point of contact for support during program:
 - Students will have teacher's contact information.
- Work with family-stay coordinator, host family, & student if there are questions or concerns while abroad.





PROGRAM TEAM: FAMILY STAY COORDINATORS

- L&F has an extensive network of teachers & friends abroad, dedicated to fostering international friendships.
- Find welcoming host families in their schools & communities.
- Meet with each family personally to discuss goals, expectations
- Available for the duration of the family stay: provide support & address any questions or concerns.



PROGRAM TEAM: HOST FAMILIES

- VOLUNTEER to welcome students; not paid.
- Host families are interested in cultural exchange & international friendships!
- ONE student per family: maximum immersion.
- Most families have children within 2 years of age of the US student.
- Visiting students may share a room with a host sibling of the same gender, but will have their own bed
- Matches are based on interests of student and family: <u>not</u> gender or age.

PROGRAM TEAM: YOU, THE TRAVELER!

- The success of your family stay also depends on YOU – your interest, openness, & willingness to invest in the experience
- Students receive in-depth preparation for this cultural experience:
 - √ Monthly prep meetings as a group
 - √ Student Guidebook
- Review the guidebook often to be prepared for the experience! Topics include:

Host family routines Meals

Greetings Rules

Spending money Going out

Group travel Phone use



YOUR FAMILY STAY PLACEMENT

- When the Language &
 Friendship coordinator
 abroad has completed the matches, L&F will e-mail you (student/parent) a letter with contact information.
- Typically, matches are received 1-3 weeks before departure. Sometimes it can take a bit longer, but rest assured, a host family will be anxiously awaiting your arrival.





PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

Behavior before trip:

- Must maintain good academic standing, demonstrate excellent behavior, and be in excellent health.
- Must attend all preparatory meetings & demonstrate a commitment to speaking the language & learning how to be a good, safe traveler – in a group!

Behavior during trip:

- Respect teacher/leaders and members of group, never venture out alone, abide by curfews and all rules.
- No alcohol, smoking, drugs, sexual involvement, tattoos or piercings, or anything else that endangers your safety or the safety and well-being of the group.

Complete Program Expectations are in Program Brochure. Parents and students sign application stating that they agree to these and will also sign a copy of the Program Expectations.



PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS:

IMPORTANT: Good Health

Students must be able to <u>self-manage</u> medication or health conditions.

- ✓ Group travel is strenuous: requires energy & flexibility!
- ✓ Travelers <u>MUST</u> report accurate and complete health information on application
- ✓ Teachers, Family Stay Coordinators, & host families must be aware of a student's health information the goal is a safe & supportive program for all involved
- ✓ Some cases may require report from physician and/or educator or counselor.
- √ Teacher's responsibility is to the whole group

COMMUNICATION EXPECTATIONS

FOR PARENTS & STUDENTS

- Overuse of a cellphone/social media can be disruptive
 & detract from the experience
- Host families feelings can be hurt if students spend more time talking with friends/family back home instead of getting to know their host family
- In case of any concerns, students should first contact the teacher/leader, instead of parents
- Teachers are the adult in a position to provide direct, local support
- Students: be in the moment!
 - Listen to the language around you
 - Learn from the people you meet
 - Live the experience!
- Parents: help support your child's efforts to immerse themselves in the experience – limited communication goes both ways!
- Before departure, teacher/leader will provide both students & parents contact information for while the group is abroad
- Language & Friendship team is available in case of questions or concerns

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Consequences for not Meeting Expectations:

Prior to Departure:

Language & Friendship reserves the right to cancel student participation at any time should there be academic, behavioral, or medical issues. Cancellation fees apply.

While abroad:

Consequences for behavior or undisclosed medical conditions revealed abroad will depend on the offense/situation. Actions may include any/all of the following:

- Address concern directly with student
- Call home to parents
- Return home at parent expense

L&F has a zero tolerance alcohol policy. Students who drink while on the program return home at parent expense.

TRAVEL SAFETY & INSURANCE

- Language & Friendship is committed to providing a safe, educational experience for each participant.
- Extensive preparation materials are provided to help ensure safety, inspire self-confidence, and facilitate communication.
- L&F regularly monitors the website of the U.S. Department of States and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO).
- L&F is in frequent communication with coordinators and partners abroad to stay informed on each region's political general climate firsthand.
- All participants covered by medical accident & sickness insurance for duration of program abroad. (See details in Program Brochure.)

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Application to be Host Family also on L&F website!

- Online application: Step-by-step instructions sent to teacher.
- Application Process:
 - Traveler Info
 - Family Stay materials (photos, letter in French, etc.)
 - Payment
 - Final Agreements (electronic signatures)
- Submit application online for teacher approval
- Teacher may ask for updates or clarification
- All requirements must be completed by enrollment deadline to finalize enrollment
